Fri, March 26	Depart San Diego via United Airline. Arrive in Dulles transfer to South African Airways flight #208 departing Washington at 5:40p to Johannesburg, South Africa.
Sat, March 27	Arrive Johannesburg at 5:20pm and transfer to Hotel. [Meals: none]
Sun, March 28	Morning visit to the Apartheid Museum which presents the history of that legal system established in 1948 in which black and "colored" South Africans were declared second- and third-class citizens. After, enjoy lunch and then visit Constitutional Hill. The constitutional Court of South Africa is Johannesburg's newest historical landmark and a unique architectural symbol of South Africa's democracy. [Meals: breakfast & lunch]
Mon, March 29	Tour of Soweto, South Africa's best-known "Black" city for an in-depth look into the lives of the people. After lunch, tour Alexandria township. [Meals: breakfast & lunch]
Tue, March 30	The day is free. [Meals: breakfast & lunch]
Wed, March 31	The day is free for University programs. [Meals: breakfast]
Thu, April 1	The day is free for University programs. [Meals: breakfast]
Fri, April 2	Check out of hotel, transfer to airport for South African Airways flight from Johannesburg to Cape Town. Upon arrival, group will transfer to hotel. [Meals: breakfast]
Sat, April 3	Tour Cape Town Townships. Group will visit District Six and the haunting District Six Museum from where a vibrant colored community was forcefully removed by the apartheid government. Tour various areas with distinct cultural differences including Langa, the oldest existing black township in the Western Cape. Lunch on tour. [Meals: breakfast & lunch]
Sun, April 4	Morning departure on a Table Mountain tour. After tour proceed to Robben Island. After tour, group will have lunch and then return to the hotel and the rest of the day is at leisure. [Meals: breakfast & lunch]
Mon, April 5	Checkout at 11am. Group will transfer to the airport. for South African Airways flight from Cape Town to Johannesburg. Upon arrival transfer to South African Airways flight #207 departing Johannesburg to Washington Dulles 5:35p. [Meals: breakfast]
Tue, April 6	Arrive Washington Dulles at 6:00a. Depart Washington Dulles to San Diego on United Airlines flight.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED: Valid passport. U.S. passport holders must have 2 consecutive blank pages in their passport not including "amendment" or "endorsement" pages. Passports must also be valid for at least 6 months after planned return date. Failure to comply with South Africa immigration bylaws will result in denied entry into the country. Passengers are responsible for ascertaining, obtaining and having with them passports, visas and other required documents. No refunds will be made to any passenger whose participation is limited or denied due to failure to process required documents.

DEPOSIT: Reservations are only considered definite upon receipt of a \$500.00, per person, deposit by check/money order made payable to E-Z TOURS, INC. Deposit is due **30 September 30, 2009**. This deposit will be applied towards the cost of the tour. This deposit is 100% non-refundable. All deposits must be paid by check or money order only. **Payment of deposit signifies full acceptance of terms and conditions set forth in this brochure.**

DEPOSIT: Additional payment of \$1500.00 is due **December 16, 2009**. This payment will be applied towards the cost of the tour. This payment is 100% non-refundable upon receipt in case of cancellation. If a total of \$2000.00 (including credit card payments) is not received by **16 December 2009**, a **\$100.00 per person late fee** will be levied. If \$2000.00 plus any applicable late fee is not received by **30 December 2009**, E-Z Tours will assume cancellation due to non-payment and no refunds will be given.

CREDIT CARDS: Credit cards are accepted for payment of the air portion of the tour. **Any credit card payments must be made by December 16, 2009. The amount that may be paid by credit card (Visa, MasterCard or American Express only) is: \$1580.00 + tax.** Taxes are approximately \$515.00. Current taxes listed are only an estimate based on taxes as of July 2009. Taxes are subject to change. Taxes are affected by fuel and security surcharges and increase at the discretion of the airline. Airfare and taxes must be charged together on 1 card at the same time. A signed imprint of credit card and a front and back copy of the credit card is required prior to **December 16, 2009**.

FINAL PAYMENT: Due no later than **February 12, 2010**. If payment in full is not received in full by February 12, 2010, **E-Z Tours will assume cancellation due to non-payment and no refunds will be given.** If a check is returned from bank for any reason there is a usd \$50.00 fee. **Mail payments to: E-Z Tours; 1650 Broadway; suite 608; New York, NY 10019.** All rates in U. S. Dollars.

CANCELLATIONS: A fee of \$500.00 per person will be levied for all cancellations received prior to 120 days before departure date. Cancellations received 120-61 days prior to departure will be levied \$850.00. There will be no refunds given for cancellations received 60-0 days prior to departure. If payment is not received in full by 2/12/10 (including any applicable late fees) E-Z Tours will assume cancellation due to non-payment with no refund given. No refunds after departure. **No refunds due to tax surcharge increases.** Refunds will not be given in the case of air transportation tax increases. Refunds are only processed upon receipt of a written request, the postmark of which determines date of cancellation.

OCCUPANCY: Double occupancy is per person with 2 adults sharing a room; Single occupancy is per person with just 1 adult in a room; Child, is per child, aged 2-11 years old sharing a room with either 2 adults who are each paying the double rate or 1 adult who is paying the single rate.

NOT INCLUDED: Air transportation taxes, security fees or fuel surcharges (currently \$515.00). Current taxes listed are subject to change. Taxes are affected by fuel and security surcharges and increase at the discretion of the airline. Tips, drinks during included lunches on tours, meals other than when specifically mentioned, fees visiting tour attractions for use of still or video cameras, portage at hotel and airport, all excess, oversize, and/or overweight baggage fees, all items of a personal nature, and all items not specifically mentioned in this agreement under "included in tour price".
