## \$1000



- All Class Levels, all majors
- 2.00 GPA or Higher
- Must be a farm worker, son or daughter of a farm worker, or spouse of a farm worker OR
- Domestic worker, son or daughter of domestic worker, or spouse of domestic worker.
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships.
- Must have a 2004-05 FAFSA on file with the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships.
- Must be a returning student for Fall 2005 semester.

### Online Application:

The application can be found by doing a Google search for:

You should see a link titled SDSU-Scholarship, which will take you to the SDSU Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships web page.

Click on Apply Online ▪ enter red ID/pin number ▪ attach your essay and transcript ▪ update the necessary information ▪ submit online ▪ forward letter of recommendation by 2/23/2005

### Letter of Recommendation:

Submit a letter of recommendation from an SDSU faculty or staff person to the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships referencing the Cesar Chavez Commemorative Scholarship.

### Essay:

Submit a two-page double-spaced essay describing your world within a farm worker family or a domestic worker family. Include in your essay what motivated you to go to college and how your upbringing influenced your decision. Describe how you have or expect to demonstrate the principles of Cesar E. Chavez to help others in the tradition he established.
