Sean Faircloth served ten years in the Maine legislature and was elected by his colleagues to the post of Majority Whip of the Maine House. A strong advocate of the separation of church and state, Faircloth has received many awards and recognition, including the 2006 Legislator of the Year Award from the Maine People's Alliance, the 2005 Excellence in Advocacy Award from the American Heart Association's Northeast Affiliate, and Legislator of the Year awards from the Maine Chapters of the American Academy of Pediatrics, The American Psychological Association, the National Association of Social Workers, and the Software Developers Association. As Executive Director of The Secular Coalition of America—representing Atheists, Humanists, Freethinkers, and the nontheistic community in the U.S.—Faircloth advocates for their concerns before the U.S. Congress and Senate.
