Preparation for the Major (13 units):

- Sociology 250 – Introduction to Social Research (3)

Note: 1) These courses cannot be taken for credit/no credit (CR/NC).
2) Statistics 119 or 250, or Biology 215, will be accepted in lieu of Sociology 201.

To be admitted to the Sociology major, students must achieve a grade of “C” or higher for each of the preparation courses listed above and an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.

The Major (27 upper division units):

All majors must complete 15 units of core requirements and 12 units of upper-division sociology electives. Major courses must be taken for a letter grade (courses graded credit will not be used to fulfill major requirements)
