We are pleased your student is interested in becoming a participant in the SDSU UBMS Summer Residential Program. Enclosed is the application for you to complete. It is essential that all forms be completely filled out before they are submitted to us. Failure to do so may delay your application process.

This year, we will be recruiting fifty high school students, including students from Arizona, California, Hawaii, New Mexico, Nevada and the Pacific Islands. We are looking for students that are currently in the **10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grades**. Our six-week summer residential program will start June 22, 2007 and will end August 4, 2007.

There will be no charge for students to attend the summer component. You and your student should know that we have an intensive program curriculum that includes classes such as Molecular Biology, Bio-Chemistry, Statistics, Computer Animation and research mentorships.
