So that's why I miss Davis, not the people but the warm spring and hot summer I know are about to begin, and all the wide open space and dirt roads out between

the UCD fields for kids to ride their bicycles on, or Putah Creek to walk beside. Tanned arms and tanned backs

and blonde hair of the bright summer and going swimming after work

with the sun just skimming the ~~out~~ surface of the water and cutting the waves of UCD pool. Bright days and
