Monday morning bright and early I visited the school library. That nice lady was there and said probably the book on Macromé was at Mrs. Hand's house. So I may call her. Mr. Field says she is doing well in spite of her recent loss. I decided that you would want your grades, Annie. They are excellent! So I paid the fine and will be reimbursed later. Dad wonders why Mrs. Hand did not give you an A. I thought perhaps you did not complete all of your projects.

Mr. Field wears beads now and still has his beard and longish hair. I meant to tell him what you were doing in Wash. D.C. When I told him you were there, he said "good, she escaped from Davis."

Yesterday, dad and I spent the day and early evening in Stockton at U. of Pacific. Dad gave his lecture study on Matthew and it was superb!

Many of the women there - 140 - were positively primitive in their understanding of theology. An added bonus was the presence of about 20 or 30 girl students on scholarships. Many were the sub-missing - non-think type. (Just haven't been exposed to life yet.) But one woman's lib gal in jeans got up during the communion service and said it already meant something to her. So all is not lost. Let's hope something will be gained during the week for them and the others. I know now why I did not want to be a district officer. I had difficulty relating to the kind of women who seem to be active in church women's groups. The really sharp gals steer clear of it.

This morning we called Carolyn about 9:30 A.M. and sang "Happy Birthday" and talked with her. She is certainly pleased with your book, Beekay. She and the church members there are preparing to go on a 2-3-week tour of historic places in the U.S. They are taking 4 bus loads (all air-conditioned and belong to the church) of ghetto kids from San Francisco where they have

a sister church. The kids pay a minimal fee, or nothing and take sleeping bags as they plan to cook and sleep out most of the time. Can you imagine what this will mean to these children and young people, most of whom are so囚禁於 the inner city?

If all of the churches could do this sort of thing, think what it would mean to the ghetto people of America? Davis Foster Children's camp is one step, but we could do more. Of course that activity is one value of being an independent Church in an autonomous system. Jim can do what he pleases and he pleases to do constructive things. But it could be done in an episcopal system too. It's an idea that needs to germinate. So anyway, we shall visit Carolyn when she returns. They leave Monday. If they reach Wash. D.C. she will call you. I doubt if they get that far south. They may, however.

Willy and Wesley, like Russia and the United States, live in a state of co-existence. Although Wesley growls when Willy shows interest and wishes to play with him, they still follow me from room to room together,

Keeping their distance. Dad walks both of them ~~from~~ at different times. I bought a leather leash and harness today. The chain leashes are not strong enough for Willy. He still chases butterflies, and we are getting him a bell so that the birds will hear him.

A card from your mother, Pat,

tells us that they'll vacation in Sept. instead of August and that Julie will be visiting you the end of July. That will be nice for Anne and Sam since they were both held down their share of the work. Too bad you do not have our bunk beds which are stored in our garage. We also have that wonderful cedar chest which will be yours when you are ready for it. Also, any other furniture in the bedrooms which you would like. We've made a ~~for~~ sketch out of your room, Beeky.

However, it is still a guest room and has a good double bed and room to move about.

I still feel so ~~hither~~ here's no there that I am saving everything but planning also to paint the old chest of drawers if

need be. Dad talks about Wash. D.C.
but believe me, it's only palaver.
I think Dick Johnson (Ch. of Youth
Camps of our Conf.) is working for him
to become a bishop. They were talking
yesterday. Dick worked in Social Con-
cerns in D.C. a while back and felt
the only executives that really cut
the mustard were Grover Babby
and John Adams. Oh well, we could
end up most anywhere. Will definitely
move from Davis next year. I already
feel as though I am elsewhere.
