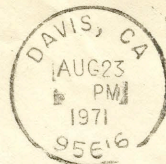

Dear Ann,

Thought I'd drop this note after our conversation tonight.

Your present pass permits you to fly ~~TWA/Stand-by~~ United Airlines, Stand-by. Becky was going to call for information about planes.

You'll have to decide how early you can get to the Dulles airport. I think that you'll be able to get on a plane Monday or Tuesday. If you catch a noon plane, I'd plan to get to the airport by 10:00 or 10:30, so that you might be first person waiting for stand-by.

If you cannot get on the United plane, check with TWA which may have a flight an hour or so later. If it looks as though you might get on TWA, buy a stand-by pass for a couple of dollars.

You'll need to ask when you get on a plane in Washington, whether your baggage will be check to Los Angeles or Sacramento.

If you have to pick it up in L.A., you go to the baggage counter by the street, a long walk from the plane underground.

Then you take baggage to United counter and get them know you want to get on the plane to Sacramento as a stand-by. If your baggage is checked through to Sac, and you fly United, you can check the counters and "Information" in the area where you get off the plane from Washington. All United planes arrive and depart from that area.

If you cannot get on a United plane, because it is too full for stand-bys, you can pay full-fare and get a regular ticket from Los Angeles to Sac.

If you have any questions, ask stewardesses, ticket agents, others!

Be sure to go to counters to check in for "Stand-by" just as soon as you arrive at the airport! Then you'll wait until almost departure time to know for certain whether they'll have room.

If you have a long enough wait in Los Angeles, call us collect and tell us when you think you'll arrive in Sac. Otherwise call us from the Sac airport.

Have a good trip, and we'll be looking forward to having you home again.
