Played Football in 1936 and 1937.
Won Southern Conference championships
those years. Position Right guard on offense
& Backing up line as Fullback. Weight
147 lbs.

Gained much fame for substituting
self in the Football game between
S.D. State & Santa Barbara in final
minutes of play, when Santa Barbara
was desperately trying to win the champion-
ship, while S.D. State was ahead 9-8.
This occurred in 1936. Fenwick was
glorified by everyone in that last
and particular football game.

To this day I can't believe that
I was the only Football player to
substitute himself without the coaches
knowledge in football history.

After I left S.D. State in 1938.
I was employed by the City of San Diego
in the S.D. Recreation Dept.

Worked there for them from 1939 to 1950.
Worked as Recreation Director in
Southeast San Diego or Logan Heights
Took charge and directed all Boys & Girls
activities, Baseball, Basketball, Football and

Basketball. Kept them out of trouble and busy during those hectic years of late 30's + 40's. Retired from Recreation Dept of San Diego in 1950.

Joined the Laborers Union and became Secretary Treasurer in 1955 to 1962. Business Agent 1980 - 1985 and worked as Business manager for Laborers Trust & Pension Dept.

Retired twice, and I now live at 345 - I St. Chula Vista, Ca.

I'm still semi-active in affairs for wayward youth. Still trying to keep them out of trouble.
