Extra note: My father was Frank M. Watenpaugh, professor of economics and accounting at SDSC until his death in 1956.

In 1945 I was "busy" being a wife and expectant mother. Since in those days most women didn't work very far into their pregnancies, I quit my job with J. Jessop & Sons, Jewelers (by the big clock on 5th Ave, downtown San Diego) and occupied myself with keeping house, hemming flannel diapers and embroidering cute baby animals and little flowers on tiny flannel sacques. In August 1945 my husband headed overseas to Japan and in September my baby girl was born. (Remember the old Quintard Hospital, over near San Diego High School? That's where I was for 10 days.)
