My life before SDSU and on through the present moment has continued to be about music and theatre. Last year, on Broadway (New York City) we had a lovely musical called "She Loves Me". This year, it has been playing in London. And we have just returned from London, where the show, after a good run, and after winning five Olivier musical awards, is closing. It was an exciting trip, although it is always sad to close a show. Now we are working on a new small musical for off-Broadway in New York, and we will open it out of town, in La Mirada, Ca. on November 3. It is called "Radio Gals". We previously gave it a tryout last January in Pasadena, at the Pasadena Playhouse, where it was a big hit. I do hope it continues that way! I think it is terrific, and we hope to bring it to off-Broadway after the first of the year.

We have two other projects in the works. One is a production of "Death of a Salesman". starring Hal Holbrook. We will open a national tour the first week in December, and will reach California March 26th, where we will play for one week in Cerritos. Our third project is a wonderful new play that we will be trying out at the Long Wharf Theatre in Connecticut, in November. But it will certainly be a full year before we will have it ready for Broadway.
