Public Works Officer, 11th Naval Dist.) & copy of Press Release for 13 Feb. 1961 re/contract for conversion of Wherry Housing Project to Public Quarters, Bayview Hills, U.S. Naval Station, San Diego – amt. = \$2,152,600.
