



#### THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CHRISTIANS AND JEWS

NCCJ was founded in 1928 by a group of eminent Americans, including Charles Evans Hughes, Newton D. Baker, S. Parks Cadman, Roger W. Straus, and Carlton J.H. Hayes, following the vicious anti-Catholic presidential campaign against Al Smith. They recognized an urgent need for an organization to combat all forms of bigotry and ignorance which would turn one group of Americans against another, thereby undermining the great promise of democracy.

Its purpose is positive: to approach more closely the national ideal of building "one nation, under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all."

It seeks the resolution of community problems by bringing to bear on them the moral insights shared by all the major religious groups and all persons of good will, who make up our pluralistic society.

NCCJ's program is educational and follows a multiple approach at various levels to the intergroup situation in the community. It reaches millions of Americans annually by conducting programs with and through existing institutions and organizations of society.

t gains support and strength from people who hold to the deep-seated belief that one's own success is best assured when he helps to assure the success of others. . .and that the rights and respect we desire for ourselves and our children can be guaranteed only by extending them to others.

NCCJ is neither a propaganda organization nor a pressure group. It does not lobby, it does not pass resolutions "viewing with alarm." It is not an "action group" in the conventional sense. But the education it seeks to promote is itself a profoundly important form of action.
