Welcome to the Aiesec International Traineeship Exchange Program. Completing this application will enable us to determine whether you are likely to be able to find a suitable International traineeship through our program and help to explain the next steps in the process toward finding a match. For over 50 years now, Aiesec has been helping young people to gain meaningful personal, professional and cultural experience in the pursuit of our mission of building greater understanding between nations. Aiesec traineeships last between 8 weeks and 18 months and start at any point during the year, giving you the flexibility to decide when the best time is for you to gain your international experience, with an on-the-ground network of student-run Local Committees in 85 countries helping you to learn about another culture - and about yourself. ## International Traineeship Exchange Process

### Application:

Complete this application and return it to your Local Committee with a check for \$45, made payable to Aiesec. This is non-refundable. Your application will be screened for your matchability in Aiesec's international pool of traineeships. Please attach your resume to this application. Your resume should include any language skills you possess and your competency in Verbal, Written, Reading and Understanding (ranked as Native, Excellent, Good or Basic in each area - note that we may require this to be tested professionally should you be accepted onto the program), any technical skills you may have and any work experience you may have.

### Interview:

You may be called for an interview either in a group or individually. The interview process is designed to screen at a basic level for your suitability to participate in a cross-cultural traineeship exchange program.

### Preparation:

In order to ensure the quality of the candidates Aiesec US is sending abroad, and the quality of your international experience, you must attend the modules of cultural preparation for your traineeship, specified by your Local Committee. You are subject to being removed from the Aiesec International Traineeship Program at any point up to being matched to a traineeship if you are not meeting these requirements.

### Matching:

At this point, Aiesec gives you access to our online database of international traineeship opportunities. You are responsible for searching through this database and communicating internationally to find a match for your preferences. (You will receive training on how best to do this most effectively). If, however you are having difficulty finding suitable matches or in international communication, you will be assigned a Personal Consultant to assist you. When you first apply to an international traineeship, you must submit a check for \$455, payable to Aiesec. Only when you finalize a match to an international traineeship will your check of \$455 will be cashed.

### Reintegration:

In order to ensure the quality of the service Aiesec provides and to reinforce your international traineeship experience, you must fulfill the requirements of cultural reintegration identified by your Local Committee and complete a post-traineeship evaluation form. You may complete these requirements at any Local Committee in the United States. Upon completing these requirements, you will be refunded \$50.
