

**MAJOR GOALS AND LEARNING OUTCOMES FOR THE
B.S.B.A. ACCOUNTANCY PROGRAM**

I. Gather, consolidate, safeguard, prepare and present accounting information for internal and external users.

Student Learning Outcomes:
