**IMPORTANT NOTES:**

1. Please note that sometimes our partner universities change their course offerings without notifying us so the courses that you listed on your Academic Approval Form may not be available for you to take for the semester that you are planning to study abroad. So please check with your host university before your departure if they'll offer the courses that you need.
2. Please note that all rules that applied to your major at SDSU apply to your study abroad program. This means that you must have completed all the prerequisites of courses before you take the ones abroad. In other words, you cannot take Finance 329, if you have not taken Finance 323, etc. Please note that the CBAbroad office Does **NOT** check if you have the prerequisites for the courses that you will take abroad. Therefore, **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to make sure to complete the prerequisites of the courses that you are planning to take abroad. Please check with your academic advisor in the major.
3. If you are taking any of the core courses that are pre-requisites for MGT 405, you must bring proof of completion from your host university, i.e., a note from your professor(s) that you completed the course(s) with a passing grade, or a transcript from your host institution so you can enroll in this class when you are back. Please note that your host university official transcripts will take a few months to be issued.
