Visa Procedures	The acceptance letter with the Certificate of Admission will be sent to the Office in charge of International Exchange. Students should submit the Certificate of Admission and other required documents to the Korean Embassy for the obtainment of a student

	visa. For Chinese students, visa issuance number will be sent to the students to their e-mail addresses for visa application.

Minimum and maximum credits	- 15-18 credits per semester(Undergraduate) Those who want to take less than 15 credits need to acquire the permission from their home University - Maximum 9 credits per semester(Graduate)
