

The AIFS program fee of \$4,740.00 includes the following:

student housing in self-catering apartments including a set amount of utilities within or close to the historic center of Florence in twin-bedded rooms with typically 4 students sharing a 2-bedroom apartment (telephones will not be available in the apartments). Students will receive a change of linen and a regular cleaning service;

orientation program upon arrival consisting of an orientation meeting with AIFS staff; student information packet containing handbooks, maps, local area information etc.; followed by a guided walking tour of Florence; and a welcome reception;

a weekly program of cultural activities including walking tours; cooking classes; ballet; and museum visits such as the Uffizi, the Accademia and the Bargello;

guided day-trip by private bus to Siena;

four-day, three-night trip to Rome including round-trip transportation, accommodation in a tourist-class hotel on a bed-and-breakfast basis, entrances to and tours of the Coliseum, Roman Forum and the Vatican, and a group meal; transfer to Naples for one night with visit to Pompeii, entrances to the excavations with guided tour, and the services of an AIFS tour manager throughout;

three-day, two-night trip to Venice including round-trip transportation, accommodation in a tourist-class hotel on a bed-and-breakfast basis, vaporetto ticket, half-day guided sightseeing tour, entrance to the Doges' Palace and Saint Mark's, group meal, and the services of an AIFS tour manager throughout;

AIFS Student Services support;

medical and program fee refund insurance policies;

\$50 non-refundable application fee.

gram fee does not include the following:

optional transportation package including round-trip transatlantic airfare from San Diego to Florence, and round-trip transfers between the airport and your program site on the specified program date(s) at a cost of \$1,350.00 (subject to change)*;

mandatory U.S. government and airline-imposed departure taxes, fees and fuel surcharges of \$327.00 (subject to change);

\$200 refundable damage deposit;

optional meal plan consisting of 20 vouchers for some lunches or dinners in local trattoria in Florence for \$320;

tuition fees to your university;

textbooks;

meals not listed above;

passport and visa fees if applicable;

additional field trips or excursions required by your instructors;

personal expenses such as laundry;

optional personal effects coverage and medical insurance upgrade.

* AIFS offers round-trip transportation between San Diego and Florence including transfers between the airport and your program site, at a cost of \$1,350.00 excluding mandatory U.S. government and airline-imposed departure taxes, fees and fuel surcharges of \$327.00 (subject to change) for which you will be billed separately.
