TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

Tuition and fees for our incoming EMBA class, matriculating August 2010, are estimated at \$48,960 (\$1,020 per unit), for our 21 month program, which includes tuition, textbooks, class handouts, course readers, welcome reception, orientation, graduation, guest speakers, annual international trip to Mexico, meals (morning and afternoon coffee breaks and lunch both meeting days), and miscellaneous fees. Special parking arrangements while in attendance will be arranged for you. The program is entirely self supporting and receives no public monies or grants in financial support of its operation. All fees are based upon projections of anticipated expenses and are, therefore, subject to annual increases. A \$500 deposit is due upon acceptance of admission to the program.
