PROGRAM INFORMATION

The 2012 Florence Summer Program is a six-week program:

June 2—July 14, 2012

The approximate \$5,900.00 program fee includes:

- Shared accommodations in self-catering apartments within the historic center of Florence
- VIP entrance to museums and attractions, including the Uffizi Gallery, Accademia, Bargello, and more.
- Medical and program refund insurance
- Services of on-site staff
- 6 units of SDSU resident credit

Not included in the program fee are transportation to Florence, meals, textbooks, optional side-trips and incidentals.

The Florence Semester Program presents students with the opportunity to enjoy a truly unique international experience that introduces them to the magnificent culture of both the past and present while they continue to make progress toward their degree.

HOUSING AND FOOD

Students are lodged in local apartments located within 20 minutes walking distance of the Study Center. Four students typically share a two bedroom apartment with cooking facilities.

For an additional fee, students may opt to purchase a meal plan featuring 15 meals at participating local eateries.

ADMISSION / PRE-REQUISITES

- This is a rigorous academic program geared towards SDSU Honors students. Priority may be given to SDSU Honors students.
- Open to SDSU students, alumni, students at other colleges and universities, and the general public.
- Applications will be accepted in the order received and program is limited to 20 participants.
- SDSU students must be in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or have approval from the program's Faculty Director.
- Minimum age to participate is 18.
