

**MIDDLE SCHOOL OPTION: STUDIO ARTS**

**INTRODUCTORY SUBJECT MATTER AUTHORIZATION IN STUDIO ARTS  
(added to your multiple subject credential)**

*For students in the LIBERAL STUDIES SPECIALIZATION IN STUDIO ARTS (AY 2009)*

If you would like to teach studio arts at the middle school level, as well as multiple subjects at the elementary level, in addition to a multiple subjects credential, you will need a total of 32 units of studio arts course work, with at least 3 units in the specific content areas as described below. The additional courses you complete to satisfy the requirements for the middle school authorization can be used as elective units for graduation (if necessary).

**REQUIREMENTS:**

**Minimum of 32 total units; at least 3 units in each content area; grade of C or higher required.**  
(units can also count towards requirements in the major\* and/or specialization^)

**Content Areas: (at least 3 units in each area)**

- 1. Art history, aesthetics and appreciation      Art 157\*, 258^, 259^, upper division art history courses
- 2. Two-dimensional art      Art 100^ (drawing), 101^ (two-dimensional design), 102 (drawing and composition), 204 (painting), 210 (printmaking), 387\*^ (art for elementary teachers)
- 3. Three-dimensional art      Art 103^ (three-dimensional design), Art 216 (sculpture), Art 220 (design in crafts), Art 323^ (beginning furniture design and woodworking), Art 325^ (beginning throwing ceramics), Art 425^ (intermediate ceramics), Art 331^ (beginning jewelry and metalwork), Art 431^ (intermediate jewelry and metalwork)
- 4. Photography/computer generated imagery      Art 240 (digital media), 340 (photographic imagery)
