A collection of letters, memorandum, telegrams, notes & other items. **Examples are:** letters (5/61) from Judge William P. Mahedy (Superior Court, San Diego & commanding officer of the Naval Reserve Law Company), Earl Cantos & Congressman Wilson re/ support for H.R. 6889 – "This bill provides career incentive for the procurement and retention of lawyers for the Naval service;" a letter (5/8/61) from Burgus C. Garrison (President, National Assn. of Supervisors, Local 36, U.S. Naval Establishment) & Wilson's reply (5/17/61) "calling my attention to [your opposition to] legislation introduced by Senator Butler and Congressman O'Konski relative to placing naval ships repair work in private shipyards;" a letter (5/23/61) from VAdm. R. B. Pirie (Deputy Chief of Naval Operations, Air) to Wilson re/ "a forthcoming realignment of permanent duty stations for certain Pacific Fleet carrier air groups and squadrons;" letters (Apr.-May 1961) from Congressmen Charles McC. Mathias, Jr. & Bob Wilson re/ promotion for Fairchild Aircraft's F-27 – a medium transport – and their regrets that the military had not procured some; a letter (5/21/61) from RAdm. M. E. Arnold (Commandant, 11th Naval District) & Wilson's reply (6/5/61) thanking the Admiral for sending an "8 x 10 beautiful photograph of San Diego taken from an altitude of 52,000 feet;" letters (Jan.-June 1961) from constituent Robin Young, Congressman Wilson & Brooks Hays (Asst. Secretary of State) re/ U.S. Naval Base at Guantanamo Bay in Cuba and suggestions about folk music; letters & Resolution (May-June 1961) from Henry A. Dietz (County Counsel, San Diego) & Wilson re/ "Resolution Adopted By the Board of Governors The State of California" re/ endorsing "the formation of a Judge Advocate General's Corps for the United States Navy;" a copy of "Compiled By the San Diego Chamber of Commerce Military Affairs Department" (7/15/61) listing of Navy Flag Officer Shore and Afloat Commands; **other topics and issues in this folder are:** letters (7/61) re/ "views of San Diego Local, Master Mechanics and Foreman Association regarding the Navy Apprenticeship Program;" News Release (8/17/61) "Navy Announces Readiness Actions;" letters (July-Aug. 1961) re/ responses to constituent complaint about "night noise problem created at Miramar Naval Air Station;" letter and note (8/61) re/ constituent complaint about his anti-communist viewpoint was insufficiently supported by the Navy; a copy of an August 25, 1961 "Fact Sheet On Recall of Naval Reservists;" letters (Aug.-Sept. 1961) re/ a constituent's suggestion to establish a naval patrol between Cuba and Florida for the purpose of rescuing Cuban refugees; letters and notes (Aug.-Sept. 1961) re/ making "Our All-Star game a success;" letters (10/61) re/ San Diego Naval Supply Center and U.S. Fleet Computer Programming Center; telegram (11/3./61) from Wilson regarding his inability to welcome the USS *Kitty Hawk* to San Diego; letters (Oct.-Nov. 1961) re/ Kiwanis Club's interest in having a Navy Cruiser named in honor of San Diego; letters (11/61) re/ constituent inquiry as to parking facilities at the Naval Station; a letter (12/6/61) from the Surgeon General of the Navy thanking Wilson for his cooperation and support; a packet of corresp. (Oct.-Nov. 1961) regarding responses to a constituent's complaint concerning

"prices at the commissary and exchange and the undesirability for overhauling San Diego based ships at Long Beach, California;" notes, letter & newsclipping (11/61) re/ Naval Supply Depot and union deductions.
