Belen (Post Office) re/ delayed delivery of Navy allotment checks; a letter (9/14/62) from C.H. Benton, Jr. (Benton, Inc.), Wilson's reply (12/19/62) and office note re/ "delay in payments by the Navy Regional Finance Office in San Diego;" letters (Nov.-Dec. 1962) from Wilson & RAdm. M. E. Arnold (Commandant, 11th Naval District) re/ "alleged practices being engaged in by some Recruit Depot and Naval Training Center personnel" to encourage recruits to "stay out of jewelry stores on Broadway;" letters (Oct.-Nov. 1962) from R. J. Reininger (Van & Storage Service), Wilson & Cmdr. Earl J. Schmitt (Officer in Charge, U. S. Navy Regional Finance Office, Washington, D.C.) - "concerning the problem of collecting revenue for storage and local handling of household goods;" letters (Aug.-Sept. 1962) from Wilson & RAdm. T. A. Long (Acting Chief of Bureau of Supplies and Accounts) re/ a constituent's "recent inquiry concerning the stocking of commissary stores;" **other topics and issues in this folder are:** letters (July-Aug. 1962) re/ MCRD maintenance officer requests more information on Executive Orders 10987 & 10988; letters (June-Aug. 1962) re/ information for Edward A. Breitbard, San Diego's Hall of Champions; letters (Mar., June & July, 1962) re/ Printing Industries Assn. of San Diego's concern that ships of U.S. Navy are purchasing "cruise books" in Japan in conflict with Dept. of the Navy orders; notes & letters (7/62) re/ responses to constituent inquiry as to "San Diego still being considered as a possible site for a new facility for the Naval Ordnance Test Station Pasadena Annex;" letters (July & Aug.) from Wilson and Thomas W. Sefton (Pres., S.D.
