J. J. Appleby (SC, U. S. Naval Training Center) & Capt. D. I. Thomas (Commander, U. S. Naval Training Center) re/ responses to Mr. Wexler's concerns that the Exchanges at military establishments were in unwarranted competition with commercial enterprises; a letter (3/22/63) from RAdm. Almon E. Loomis to Wilson re/ priority listing of military construction as printed in the *S.D. Union* on March 22; a large stapled packet containing letters ((Apr.-May 1963) from RAdm. John E. Clark (Commander, Pacific Missile Range, Point Mugu), Wilson, a copy of a "suggested itinerary" for a visit to the Missile Range, a large foldout map of the Arguello/Vandenberg area & a congressional committee print, "Cape Canaveral The Hope of the Free World," REPORT of the Committee on Science and Astronautics" (1962); a news clipping from the *San Diego Union* (1/10/63, pages 1-4) re/ "Navy To Construct Floating Lab Here" off Point Loma; a letter (1/25/63) from Capt. E. C. Ogle (Executive Deputy Chief, Office of the Secretary of the Navy) & enclosed "Fact Sheet On U. S. Naval Air Station, North Island" re/ "proposed reduction in the civilian work force;" photocopy of "Flag & General Officers, San Diego Area 1 April 1963;" **other topics and issues in this folder are:** CNO letter (29July63) to Wilson re/ personal commentaries; letters & notes (July-Aug. 1963) re/ response to a constituent's concern about "the difficulties our San Diego based destroyers are having in funding their needs for maintenance supplies;" letters (Jul.-Aug. 1963) re/ complaint & response between Lodge 726 IAM & Commander NEL; letters (8/63) re/ responses to conservative constituent about the "maneuverability" of PT 109 & its loss; letters (Aug. & Sept. 1963) re/ Destroyer Squadron Twenty-One and Wilson's interest in meeting the Commander; letters (Aug.-Sept. 1963) & news clippings re/ "recent attacks on housewives in the Moanalua Terrace Housing at Honolulu;" letters (9/63) re/ information on "High Explosive Magazine located on Point Loma;" Memorandum (9/6/63) re/ discussion on Veterans Hospital location & North Island's ability to handle overhaul and repair of the Sikorsky 27 C H-3C Helicopters; constituent letter & response (Sept. & Oct. 1963) re/ potential violation of federal law by "amateur radio operator;" letters, telegram & notes (Sept.-Oct. 1963) re/ "inquiry concerning reduction in the civilian work force at the Naval Amphibious Base and Naval Training Center in the San Diego area."
