A collection letters, notices, listings, notes, newsletter & other items. **Examples are:** Public Notice & map (12/9/64) from Lt. Col. A. R. Marshall (Deputy District Engineer, Corps of Engineers) re/ the establishment of a restricted area adjacent to Point Loma – south of Ballast Point; letters (Oct.-Nov. 1964) from constituent Miss Loraine S. Duval, Congressman Wilson & Adm. David L. McDonald (CNO) re/ a response to concerns about "North Viet Nam gunboats . . . trailing our naval ships, our ships could not defend themselves . . . [because of alleged] shortage of parts;" letters (Sept.-Oct. 1964) & attached copy of "SECNAV INSTRUCTIONS 1740.1 (20 Dec. 1960) – "Commercial solicitation controls abroad installations of the Naval Establishment" re/ complaints about solicitations favoring one insurance company over others; a letter (10/29/64) from El Cajon constituent Roy N. Dahlstrom & Wilson's reply (11/4/64) re/ misinformation on where USS *Enterprise* would be homeported; listing of 11 major ship yards and civilian personnel at each yard (7/64), a "List of Installations" for Aeronautical Depot Maintenance "Being Studied For Possible Closing by Taylor Board;" a letter (9/29/64) from Congressman Wilson, a night letter from his secretary & a reply (12 Oct. 1964) from Under Secretary of the Navy Paul B. Fay, Jr. re/ date the USS *Magoffin* (APA-199) is expected to return to the United States – this was in response to "many angry and crying [Navy] wives;" **other topics and issues in this folder are:** a letters (10/1/64) from Asst. Secretary of Defense Arthur Sylvester to Wilson "urging accreditation of news correspondence to United States Ships patrolling near the Vietnamese coast;" letters (Oct.-Nov. 1964) re/ "request for the U.S. Navy to lift a stone image from Easter Island to Chile;" a Nov. 16, 1964 letter from the Secretary of the Navy Paul Nitze congratulating Wilson on his re-election and working with Wilson on matters of mutual concern; letter & press release (Nov.-Dec. 1964) re/ construction contract for "Wells Air-Start Systems" for North Island; packet of corresp. (Aug.-Dec. 1964) re/ a constituent military retiree contested a \$10 traffic ticket he received at MCRD; letters (12/64) to President Johnson contesting the current move to return to a 20 percent private shipyard work vs. the 35/65 law; letters (Aug. 1964) re/ dredging for Del Mar Boat Basin & CNO letter on Ship Repair Facility; packet of corresp. (July-Sept.,1964) & map and commentary on "Departure Pattern" for Miramar Naval Air Station, planned community development & noise ratings; letters (9/64) & photocopy of editorial from the Los Angeles *Times* (8/18/64) re/ Gulf of Tonkin & alleged lack of flag flying on Navy ships; letters (9/64) re/ responses to constituent complaints about mail delayed from USS *Magoffin*; letters (10/64) & copy of NAS, *The Dispatcher's* (Vol. 5, Oct.'64) re/ tribute to Orris "Pat" Carter; copy of a telegram (9/30/64) from Mayor Frank Curran to Sec. of Defense McNamara re/ praise for NAS North Island repairs for Pacific Fleet and employment in San Diego; letters & phone message (9/64) re/ complaints about delayed mail deliveries to & from Vietnam for naval ships; letter (12/22/64) from Vera R. Glaser (Washington D.C.) to Wilson re/ questions about the Secretary of the Navy's yacht, *Sequoia*.
