Federal Government: Navy—North Island Dispensary
1963-1964

A small collection of letters, office notes, telegrams, news clippings and a press release. **Examples are:** a letter (2/6/63) from Spring Valley constituent Mrs. Doris E. Mapes & Congressman Wilson's reply (3/11/63) re/ a long and informative letter listing the pros and cons as to availability of care in the outpatient clinic at Balboa Naval Hospital & Wilson's comment that the Bureau of Medicine planned to reopen an Outpatient Clinic at the 32nd Naval Station; a letter (1/30/63) from Spring Valley constituent Fred J. Wright, Jr. & Wilson's reply (3/11/63) re/ similar problems with obtaining outpatient treatment for dependents at the Naval Hospital and Wilson's reply as above; a letter (3/7/63) from Coronado constituent Mrs. Mary H. Murray & Wilson's reply (3/13/63) re/ "overcrowded dispensary at North Island (Coronado);" a letter (3/7/63) from RAdm. M. F. Leslie, Ret. & Wilson's reply (3/13/63) re/ North Island Dispensary; a letter (3/10/63) from Coronado constituent Mrs. Mary E. Casey, enclosed news clipping & Wilson's reply (3/15/63) re/ the topic of overcrowding at outpatient clinics, the closing of the facility at North Island and the reactivation of three wings at the Naval Station outpatient clinic; **other items in this folder are:** several letters & telegrams (3/63) from Coronado constituents & Wilson's replies re/ the closing of the North Island Dispensary; Memorandum & telephone conversation notes (3/63) re/ "Navy installing a new or improved Outpatient Clinic in San Diego at the Naval Hospital;" a letter (6/23/63) from Surgeon General RAdm.
