Federal Government: Navy – 11th Naval District

1958-1962

A small collection of letters, news clippings & office notes. **Examples are:** a letter (12/22/58) from RAdm. Charles C. Hartman (Commandant, 11th Naval Dist.) & Congressman Wilson's reply (1/30/59) re/ commentary on sewage disposal plant on Point Loma and transfer of Brown Field to City, plus personal items; a news clipping from the *Union* (12/20/58) entitled "Layoffs Avoided In Navy Cutbacks, Officials Explain;" letters (May-July 1960) from constituent R. W. Mueller (M.D.), Congressmen Wilson & Utt & RAdm. E. W. Grenfell (Asst. Chief of Naval Operations (Logistics) re/ Doctor Mueller's attempts, since 1953, to eliminate Miramar jet training hazards;" letters (May-June 1961) from constituent K. Niek Shik (Chula Vista Chamber of Commerce), Wilson & RAdm. M. E. Arnold (Commandant, 11th Naval District) re/ the request for Navy participation in the 50th Anniversary Observance of the City of Chula Vista was denied; 1 letter (7/22/60) from Congressman Wilson and attached news clipping from the *Union* (7/7/60) re/ "Adm. Arnold Takes Post Tomorrow;" letters (Dec. 1959-Jan.1960) from La Jolla constituent Robert E. Jackson (E. F. Hutton & Co.), Wilson & RAdm. Charles C. Hartman (Commandant, 11th Naval Dist.) re/ a reply to Mr. Jackson's complaints about "seeing a picture in the San Diego Union last week of an incoming aircraft carrier [USS *Lexington*] with a Chinese Junk on its deck;" a letter (11/23/19) from Wilson to Commandant Hartman re/ "personal congratulations to the officers and men of Naval Reserve Security Group Division 11-1 of San Diego;" news clippings from the *Evening Tribune* & the *Coronado Journal* (11/26/58 & 1/8/59) re/ "Navy Discusses School Transfer" & "Navy okays tenant plan;" letters (7/59) from Congressman Wilson & VAdm. C. E. Ekstrom (Commander, Sixth Fleet) & news clipping from the *Evening Tribune* (6/23/59) re/ "6th Fleet Chief To Succeed Pride;" letters (1/60) from Congressmen John E. Fogarty & Bob Wilson re/ "personal note with reference to a close friend and former constituent who is now a resident of your congressional district;" a letter (1/10/62) from 11th Naval District Commandant Arnold to Wilson re/ personal commentary; letters (July-Aug. 1962) from Maggie Young (Wilson's Secretary in San Diego), La Mesa constituent Theodore Ketterer, Wilson, RAdm. M. E. Arnold & news clipping (n.d., n.s.) "Curious Wives Capture FBI Paint Sleuths" re/ painting contract for Navy Wherry Housing at Cabrillo Heights and Bayview Hills in National City" does not comply with specifications."
