Meginniss (Cong. Liaison Div., Office of the Secretary) & Capt. E. G. Underhill (Ex. Asst. to Chief of Bureau, Bureau of Yards and Docks) re/ a query about housing in Japan, while nice, are not up to the standards of naval housing in the U.S.; letters (Apr.-May 1963) from N.E. Buchanan (Head, Distribution Control Section, BuPers) re/ Mr. Smay's inquiry as to why the USS *Perch's* homeport was changed from San Diego to Subic Bay, Philippines on 1 January 1963; letters (May-July 1963) from San Diego constituent Mrs. Carl Greenwood, Wilson, Cmdr. Hal G. Wynne (Cong. Liaison Div., Office of the Secretary of the Navy) & Capts. E. G. Underhill & Will J. Davis (Ex. Assist. to Chief of Bureau, Bureau of Yards and Docks) re/ "difficulties of managing on a service budget when raising three children" of \$382.00 a month with so much going out for rent in contrast to rents on the East Coast; a letter (n.d.) from Robert Weaver (Administrator, Housing and Home Finance Agency) to Governor Edmund G. Brown & attached copy of Governor's Advisory Commission, *Summary of Housing in California*, January 1963; letters (Sept.-Nov. 1963) from El Cajon constituent Mrs. Mary A. Baker, Wilson, Commissioner Philip N. Brownstein (FHA) & attached copy of *Senior Citizen's Sentinel* (Vol. 21, No. 3, Sept. 1963) re/ "Elderly Housing Being Sabotaged! & responses on this threat to the Antelope Valley Senior Citizens Village; **other issues and topics in this folder are:** letters (Oct.-Nov. 1963) re/ "alleged housing conditions that exist for Navy dependents on Okinawa;" excerpts from the *Congressional Record – Appendix & Senate*, (Feb. & Sept. 1963); & letters (Sept.-Oct. 1963) re/ complaints about government housing (PQ2) located near the Naval Training Center in San Diego.
