A collection of letters that are not filed chronologically. **Examples are:** letters (July & Aug., 1956) from Veterans Benefits Office to Wilson acknowledging letter from Congressman regarding the Valencia Plaza Subdivision; a letter (6/27/56) signed by a number of veterans to Wilson "to acquaint you with what we believe to be an unfair and unjust dealings in connection with the construction of Valencia Plaza Subdivision G.I. Homes in San Diego, California;" copies of letters (9/11/56) from Wilson to five constituents re/ complaints about the Valencia Plaza Subdivision; a letter (9/6/56) from Ralph Stone (Chief Benefits Dir., V.A.) to Wilson re/ defects in the homes of veterans in the Valencia Plaza Subdivision. **Additional similar topics on this subject are:** letter (6/12/56) from Louis Feller (Pres., Lomax Const Co., Inc.) in reply to complaints from veterans regarding the V. A. housing constructed by Lomax; a collection of letters (July & Aug. 1956) from five veterans and responses from the V. A. & Wilson re/ a long listing of "Errors and Omissions in Construction of dwellings on La Paz Drive in this subdivision.
