Diehl, Jr. and others re/ "Alleged unlicensed operation in the Citizens Radio Service;" photocopies of telegrams (10/5 & 10/7/61) from Point Loma Sport Fishing Assn. & FCC re/ the request for a 10 day extension in answering FCC letters was granted; photocopy of a letter (10/18/61) from Ben F. Waple (FCC) to William E. Poole re/ "Alleged unlicensed operation . . . Radio Station WA-9609; photocopy of 3 page letter (10/19/61) from Edwin B. Diehl, Jr. (President & owner of Boat *New Bluefin*) to Ben F. Waple (FCC) re/ "We take exception to the allegation that we are engaging in the unlicensed operation of radio apparatus . . . on board the vessel *New Bluefin*;" photocopies of letters (10/20/61) from Wayne L. Miller (Sec'y. & Treasurer. Owner, Boat *Captain Midnight*) and 6 other officers of Point Loma Sport Fishing Assn. & boat owners to Ben F. Waple (FCC) challenging the allegation of illegal radio station operation; photocopy of a letter (10/25/61) from William E. Poole (Owner – Boat *Polaris*) to Ben F. Waple re/ "Reply to Interrogatories;" letters (Oct.-Nov. 1961) from William V. O'Neal (Mgr., Point Loma Sport Fishing Assn., Tedson J. Meyers (Admin. Asst. to the Chairman, FCC) & Wilson re/ alleged unlicensed operations; letters (11/61-1/62) re/ further information on this topic and Wilson's assistance in trying to reconcile this issue for his constituents.
