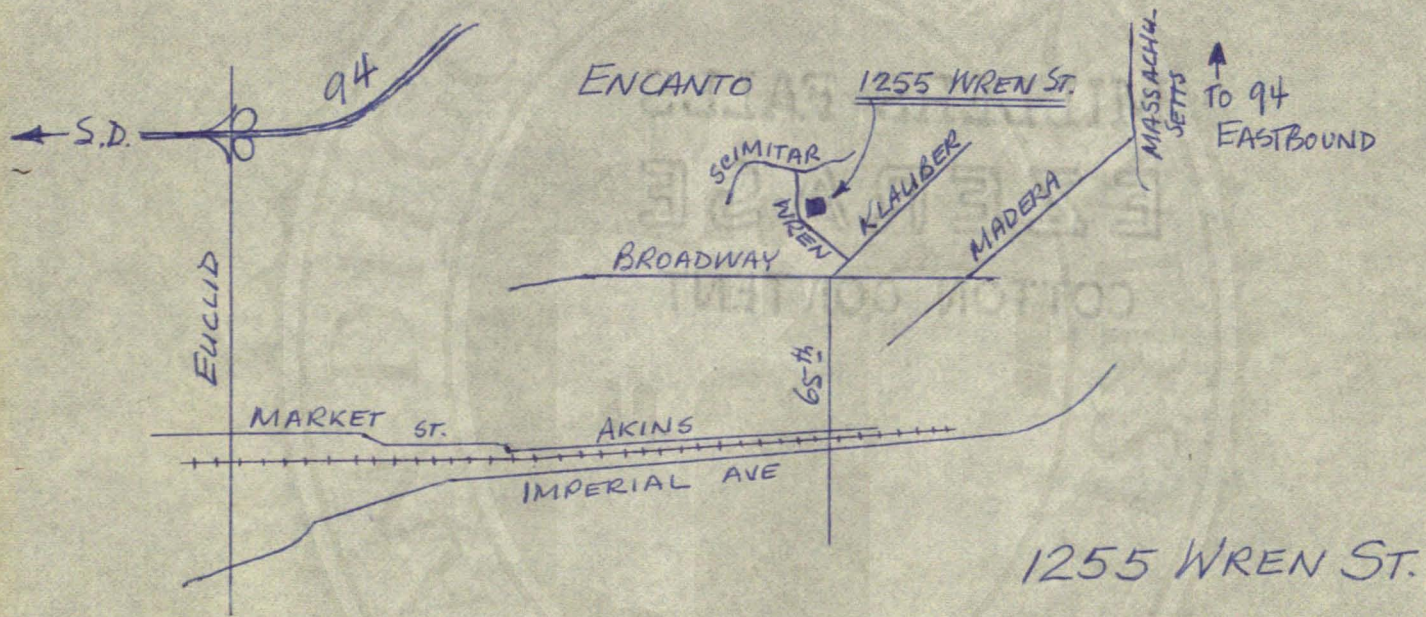


CURE urges you to vote NO on Proposition No. 1 because:

- (1) It proposes to reduce taxes and limit expenditures. This can only be done by reducing or limiting funds spent for education, law enforcement, highways, parks and social services. Racial and ethnic minorities are a disproportionately large portion of the economically disadvantaged who most need quality education and social services in order to become economically independent citizens. Proposition No. 1 would further penalize them, and in fact penalize us all, by handicapping their upward mobility.
- (2) The proposed income tax reduction would benefit those with high incomes, not those with low and middle incomes. The legislature has already granted full state income tax relief to low-income taxpayers, who now pay \$15 a year at most. A family would have to earn \$35,000 per year to save the \$804 in the first four years as claimed by the proponents for an "average" family. A typical (median) family earns \$13,000 a year, not \$35,000. A typical family would save only \$140 over four years.
