

## Background of Interracial Experiences

- Sue's involvement with interracial projects began while she was in high school in Cincinnati, Ohio. She was responsible for developing music and dance programs for black and white teen-agers at inner city community centers. She was recognized by the city council for her work in building better racial relations among teen-agers.
- 1963-1965 Throughout her secondary teaching assignment at Alpha in the West Indies, Sue worked closely with a multiracial faculty. She had the opportunity to teach young people of myriad cultural and racial backgrounds. In addition to her involvement with the secondary school system, Sue worked at a government institution for de-linquent girls from the Kingston slums where she was able to use music as a means of restoring the selfesteem of these young women. She also initiated a project in which the high school students from Alpha were able to bring food and clothing to the elderly who were living in the slums of Kingston and also brought similar volunteer services to the government's "poor house" which was inadequately staffed and financed. Bustamante, who was prime minister at the time, recognized publicly Sue's efforts at developing social awareness skills in Jamaica's youth.
- Fall, 1966 As part of Sue's studies in sociology at Columbia
  University, she lived with a black family in Harlem
  for approximately three months. The purpose of this
  project was to sensitize the participants to the "real"
  living conditions of economically deprived black families.
  While she lived in this tenement environment, Sue worked
  in the psychiatric wards of Bellevue Hospital as a recreational therapist where she once again worked successfully
  with people of varied ethnic backgrounds.
- Sue was stationed in Arua, Uganda, during her Peace Corps experience. She lived with and among the local tribes, Kakwa, Alur and Baganda. In addition to her secondary teaching assignment at an all-male vocational school,

she developed an adult education program for the local primary school teachers. She also did community development work in the area of home management with the local women.

1974-1978 Sue has conducted various courses in human relations throughout San Diego Unified School District. Her most recent programs have been held at Webster, Keiller, Freese and Audubon. She has worked with racially mixed groups through her in-service programs and her informal talks and presentations throughout the district.

She is grateful for the rich and varied experiences she has had which have contributed to her interracial awareness and her in-depth understanding of the complexity of the issues underlying the integration process.

I have just read in the paper where Judge Welsch has appointed you in charge of the task force.

I would like to volunteer to be on the committee or at least be able to voice my opinion. I am a parent of two children, ages 5 and 10, currently enrolled in Marcy School. I have been a volunteer in both children's classes one day a week since they have started school. I tried to voice my ideas to the intergretion committee and it was just like talking to a brick wall.

The <u>so called</u> volunteer program is a farce when you receive a notice telling you to sign or find another school and when the principal will not talk to the parents about the new so <u>called</u> enrichment program. A group of parents went to Grantville Elementary School and saw the <u>wonderful</u> program with equipment that was purchased with <u>unlimited</u> funds and then we saw the 3rd grade level of English and Math programs for 5th and 6th graders.

I feel it is more important that a child be able to read, add and spell than to paint like Vincent van Gough and play a piano like Wolfgang Mozart. In later life, it won't help put food on the table.

Since we have to get together in this situation, lets spend the money on the basics and maybe have the majority children helping the minority or whoever needs the help. It would help the children get acquainted and become friends which is our goal.

I feel that the committee should consist of people who are involved and want to make the schools a better place for all the children and not someone who is doing it just to be civic minded and get the best citizen award.







