Immigration and Naturalization: Visa

July-Dec. 1964

A large collection of letters, memos, memorandum, government notices, telephone messages, office notes & telegrams. These are filed from December to July. **Examples are:** A large packet of letters (May-Dec. 1964) re/ Immigrant visa case of Antonio Ortega Valencia as sponsored by Spring Valley constituent and Wilson friend, Robert F. Cahill; letters (Sept.-Dec. 1964) re/the cases of Mrs. Gananian and her daughter Anahid Kevorkian as refugee-escapees from Greece under the Act of July 14, 1960; letters (11/64) re/ constituent interest in visa case of Martha Godoy Expericueta & attached copy of commentary from American Consulate General, Tijuana as to priority systems for visas; stapled packet of corresp. (Sept.-Nov. 1964) re/ visa processing for Mrs. Diana Salvatora Boafore Sanfilippo; copies of U.S. Dept. of State, *Bureau of Security and Consular Affairs-Visa Office*, nos. 132-135, 8/64 to 11/64 re/ list of "Status of Quotas" of various countries; letters & notes (10/64) re/ medical permit for Mrs. Amparo Zumaya Vidua de Mayon; letters (Aug.-Sept. 1964) re/ Julian Tool & Fuel seeks assistance from Wilson to obtain visa permit for a prospective employee, Jose Prieto Ruiz; letters (May-Aug. 1964) re/ constituent serving in Germany receives assistance from Wilson in obtaining visa for his wife in Italy, Mrs. Maria Rodriguez; letters (July-Oct. 1964) re/ La Mesa constituent Mrs. Coulston receives assistance from Wilson in obtaining visa for her son Murray Donald Bunton and family living in Canada; letters & memo (Sept.-Oct. 1964) re/ Spring Valley constituent's son, born in Germany, can visit Mexico without visa; letters (Jan.-Nov. 1964) re/ La Mesa constituent sponsor's visa for Tijuana resident, Miss Oliva Magdalena Viveros; letters (Oct.-Nov. 1964) re/ complications for San Diego constituent obtaining visa for sister, Mrs. Rosa Di Bona Manno, living in Palermo, Italy; **other corresp. in this folder includes many more examples of the above listed immigrant visa processing:** see 11/64 – Yugoslavia; 7/64-9/64 – Dr. Gigliotte & Italy; 7/64-10/64 – Naruko Moody -- Okinawa; 9/64-10/64 – Linda Carol Jones – Canada; 9/64-10/64 – Baldomero Sierra Luna – Mexico; **other locations are** -- Barbados, Cuba, Mexico, Japan, Turkey, Italy, Germany; Iran, Philippines; Czechoslovakia/Ukrainian refugee, Greece, Canadian married to U.S. citizen & a packet of items on immigration visas from the American Consulate General, Tijuana.
