A large collection of letters, notes, news clippings, & a legal brief. **Examples are:** a stapled packet of letters (1957) from constituent Mrs. Eunice E. Boyer, Wilson, Norman H. Parks (Parks Newspaper Brokerage Service), RAdm. R. E. Cronin (Chief of Industrial Relations, Dept. of the Navy) & Homer V. Prater (Legislative Representative, American Federation of Government Employees) re/ Mrs Boyer's occupational injury while employed at the U. S. Naval Electronics Laboratory, San Diego & the complications that ensued; letters & office note (1957-1959) from Congressmen Billy Matthews & Bob Wilson, Cathy (Sec. for Wilson), Major B. Miles Hammond & the Honorable L. N. Turrentine (Judge, Superior Court, San Diego County) re/ estate settlement in San Diego & reference to former Congressman Phil Swing; letters (Jan.-Mar. 1959) re/ Wilson's assistance to constituent Archie M. Summers as to employment at the Naval Repair Facility and WW II veteran Summers potential loss of his home because of unemployment; letters (Feb-Mar. 1959) from an Imperial Beach constituent, Wilson & Commissioner W. L. Mitchell (HEW) re/ a complicated case of an ex husband's failure to pay child support and the attempts to use Social Security files to obtain his address; a stapled packet of letters & notes (Jan.-Mar. 1959) re/ "concerning a grand jury investigation in San Diego of the grocery industry" & reference to the *Ellis vs. Dallas* case; letters, news clipping & office note (July 1957 & Oct.-Nov. 1958)) re/ long letters from Jack C. Sherwood (San Ysidro, CA) to Wilson discussing illegalities in Mexico; a letter (7/23/59) from constituent Mrs. Dora Houle & Wilson's reply (7/27/59) re/ Wilson's assistance to Mrs. Houle as to the estate of "the late Sergeant Guy F. Austin;" letters (7/59) from Wilson re/ a response to the concerns of constituent E. L. Bentley & reference to District Attorney Don Keller; letters (7/59) re/ Wilson replies to letter from constituent Duke Goodwin; letters (July-Sept. 1959) re/ responses to inquiry from constituent B. G. Snow attempting to locate his ex-wife & his two minor children; letters (Aug. & Oct. 1959) re/ Dept. of State response to inquiry from constituent Mrs. Gabriel Fenyves ; stapled packet of letters, note & legal brief (June-Nov. 1959) re/ attorney contesting a hardship discharge from the Bureau of Naval Personnel related to his client's divorce proceedings – *Reynolds vs Reynolds*; letters (Oct.-Nov. 1959) re/ responses to inquiry from constituent Mrs. Priscilla J. Waugh as to lack of child support from her Marine Corps husband; letters & office note (Nov.-Dec. 1959) re/ constituent appeals to Wilson to help in the alleged plagiarism of a song by commercial TV; a letter (6/27/64) from constituent Mrs. Juanita G. Martinez & Wilson's reply (7/1/64) re/ a complicated story related to assistance given to a Tijuana couple and their failure of repayment for this aid. Wilson refers Mrs. Martinez to contact the Legal Aid Society in San Diego.
