Krieger, and Mrs. Emily Hardie, who are arriving together from London on Pan American Flight 121 on September 11, 1959 at 2:10 p.m.;" letters (May & June) re/ Courtesy of the Port in New York for Mrs. L. F. Abbot aboard the SS NIEW AMSTERDAM instead of the SS AUGUSTUS.
