

## QUALITIES OF LEADERS

- (1) Qualities: Intelligence and skill, forcefulness, teaching ability, and strength; he must be kind, fair and sensitive to the feelings of his followers.
- (2) Traits: Social intelligence; large sympathy with one's group; social imagination; moral and physical courage; a capacity for enthusiasm; complete consecration to the cause he represents.
- (3) Outward Signs: Ascendance of manner and physique; high motility; social participation and drive.
- (4) Demonstrations of the above by: Increasing the opportunities for the development of other persons; promoting the welfare of groups as such; taking the side of injustice against special privileges; showing an at-one-ness with the humbler members of society; consulting with authorities, even opponents, before acting; using the discussion method of securing adjustments; showing the way and sacrificing self; rendering service without expectation of reward.

In general I would classify "leadership" into two types:

- (1) The SAINTS who have given us the inspiration to achievement.
- (2) The DOERS who have the ability to get the results in the sport, war, political and business worlds.
